

# 2 Materiality


#### **Material Universe Matters!**



## Eternal Value of Work

Will there be annihilation or transformation between the present order and the future order? (Miroslav Volf)

- ◆ If the world is annihilated and a new one created ex-nihilo then work has no ultimate significance - except in purification of our souls in preparation for heaven.
- ♦ if the world is not annihilated but renewed, then human work has eternal significance.
  - → Jesus' resurrection and final bodily resurrection of the dead
  - ◆ Coming Kingdom (Mat 6:10); Creation liberated from its bondage and brought into freedom & glory (Rom 8:21)
  - ◆ Rev 21:25 Kings will bring their glory and valuables into it




